Two Responses
Matt 7:21-23 Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. 22 Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' 23 And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!'
The responses are to do the will of God or not. These are people doing things in the name of the one they call, yet they are still practicing lawlessness. Jesus does not deny what they have done. He is denying that they were ever part of His king-
dom. Many people will live their entire lives they are on the right path only to find out when it is too late that they have been deceived by the devil.
